

# Gas cylinders

- do you comply with current regulations?



If you are using, transporting, shipping or refilling compressed gas cylinders you must comply with current safety regulations. Hydrogen or compressed gas cylinders must be shipped in compliance with dangerous goods regulations.

The European Agreement Concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR) regulations have now been implemented to protect everyone directly or indirectly involved with transportable pressurised equipment.

The Carriage of Dangerous Goods regulations (S.I.1348 2009) have recently been revised to comply with current ADR requirements. Shipment of compressed gases must be performed by trained personnel within suitable vehicles, carrying the relevant documentation and equipped with the recommended PPE and emergency response.

Cylinders shipped to Quantitech for refill must be date stamped to comply with periodic inspection and hydraulic test regulations laid out in BS EN 1803: 2002. Out of date cylinders cannot be refilled or shipped.
